EXCLUSION FROM AND RETURN TO SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS FORM – Updated 3.4.21

As of March 1, 2021, the following guidance applies relative to exclusion of an individual from a parish/school facility after exposure to COVID-19:

As of March 1, 2021, the following capacity restrictions are in place to mitigate the spread of COVID-19:

- Face coverings are required.
- Operations must implement safety protocols, including social distancing, hygiene practices, and cleaning/sanitizing.
- Telework must continue unless impossible.
- Business Operations at 75% occupancy with social distancing
 - Exception: Indoor eating, indoor gyms, and indoor entertainment at 50% occupancy with social distancing.
- Social Gatherings
 - o Indoor: 15% occupancy with social distancing
 - Outdoor: 20% occupancy with social distancing
