

Advanced Sophomores Summer Reading 2021

Sophomores in the Advanced Exploring Literature & Writing Class must read the following:

Lord of the Flies – William Golding
The Chocolate War – Robert Cormier
The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde – Robert Lewis Stevenson

After reading, all sophomores must write an essay that answers the following prompt:

In a literary work, a motif is a repeating symbol or theme which contributes to the novel as a whole. In a well-developed essay, discuss how the motif of good versus evil is developed throughout *Lord of the Flies*, *The Chocolate War*, and *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* and the relationship it develops with the protagonist.

The requirements for the essay are as follows:

- A 5 paragraph essay, including an introduction and conclusion.
- A minimum of 3 quotes. You must use at least <u>one</u> quote from <u>each</u> novel.
 - O Use proper MLA style in-text citations (Author pg. #)
- MLA formatting
 - o Heading (your name, your teacher's name, the class name, the date)
 - o Title
 - o A readable 12-point font (Times New Roman or Calibri)
 - o 1-inch margins

Essays will be submitted to your individual teacher by Friday, August 27. Your teacher will instruct you on submitting the essay the first day of class.
