## Catholic Educator's Service Scholarship

At Central Catholic, we value those who have committed their lives to education, particularly those at one of our diocesan elementary schools. We know that sending your children to a diocesan school is a financial commitment, but one that is important to so many of you. For that reason, we have created the Catholic Educator's Service Scholarship.

The *Catholic Educator's Service Scholarship* will be awarded to students whose parent has been a full-time employee (teacher or staff) of a diocesan elementary school for at least three years. The awards will be based off the length of service of the parent as well as the academic record of the student. Students can earn up to \$6,000 annually with this scholarship.

All applications will be reviewed by the admissions staff and students will be notified if they have received the scholarship when they receive notification of their admission to Central Catholic in February. Our *Catholic Educator's Service Scholarship* recipients will receive up to \$6,000 annually for each of their four years at Central Catholic, provided, they maintain a minimum 3.2 unweighted GPA each semester, do not exceed 25 conducts points for the school year, and their parent maintains employment at a diocesan elementary school. GPAs will be reviewed at the end of each semester. Students not meeting the minimum 3.2 GPA will be placed on a one semester probationary period. Failure to raise the GPA will result in loss of the scholarship at the conclusion of the academic year.

Families who are interested in applying for this scholarship must fill out an application which will include information regarding the parent's employment. In addition, written documentation from the parent's principal stating full-time employment and years of service must be submitted. Written documentation must be updated each year in order to maintain the scholarship.

**Applications are due no later than January 1, 2022.**
