

Honors Sophomores Summer Reading 2023

Sophomores in the Honors Exploring Literature & Writing Class must read the following:

Lord of the Flies – William Golding The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde - Robert Louis Stevenson

After reading, all sophomores must write an essay that answers the following prompt:

In a 5-paragraph essay, discuss and explain how *Lord of the Flies* and *The Strange Case of Jekyll and Hyde* illustrate a cautionary tale of evil, power, and revenge. In other words, explain the moral or lesson when society grapples with corrupt leadership.

The requirements for the essay are as follows:

- A five-paragraph essay (minimum), including an introduction and conclusion.
- A minimum of 3 quotes. You must use at least <u>one</u> quote from <u>each</u> novel.
 - Use proper MLA style in-text citations (Author pg. #)
- MLA formatting
 - Heading (your name, your teacher's name, the class name, the date)
 - Title
 - A readable 12-point font (Times New Roman or Calibri)
 - 1-inch margins

Essays will be submitted to your individual teacher by Thursday, August 31. Your teacher will instruct you on submitting the essay during the first day of class.
